Green Waste/Yard Waste Facility Opens March 1st: The Yard waste drop off facility opens on March 1st at the end of Mill Street in Riverview City Park. Use restricted to City residents, no contractors. Material restricted to yard waste, leaves, grass clippings, brush, flowers, shrubs and tree cuttings. Ways to pay your Platte City Utility Bill

On line CREDIT/ DEBIT Card: Set up your monthly credit or debit payments at www.plattecity.org/online . Convenience fee applies to this option.

Bank Check Payment: Set up City of Platte City up as a payee through your bank and let them send your payment to the City. Give your bank 3 to 5 days to get the check to us.

Automatic Bank Draft: Your bank can automatically make your payment each month with this option. Fill out application at City Hall along with voided check.

Pay by mail or in person at City Hall, 400 Main Street. After hours drop box on Fourth Street

Changes coming to our Recycling Program!

The City was recently awarded \$33,765 in grant funds from Mid-America Regional Council's Solid Waste Management District to expand and update our recycling program. We will announce more details in the next few weeks, but changes will include a new recycling truck, larger recycling bins, and the ability to accept more recyclable materials!

Runner Safety Tip: Be visible/be safe. Wear bright, reflective running gear, especially in winter. Help drivers see you by wearing highly visible clothing such as reflective vests and bright, light colored outerwear. Also run, walk or jog on sidewalks where available; run or jog facing into traffic if you must be on the street.

Permits are required for most building, home addition and remodeling jobs including structural work, plumbing, electrical, decks, fences and accessory buildings. Weeds and Grass

In accordance with the Platte City Code weeds or grass are not to attain the height of twelve (12) inches or more or permit the accumulation of dead brush, branches, or other plants. The word "weeds", shall include all vegetable growths except cultivated plants, trees and shrubs. The City of Platte City does not permit the burning of leaves, yard waste, or trash.
