2013 Spring Clean-Up: April 23, 24, 25, & 26

Our annual spring clean-up will be here soon! Large and bulky items will be picked up on your regular trash pick-up day; please have items out by 6:30 a.m.

The following items will be picked up free of charge:

- ◆ Brush and small limbs (cut to 4' lengths and bundled)
- ◆ Yard waste – leaves and grass clippings (bagged in paper bags only)
- ◆ Tires (limit of 4 per household)
- ◆ Appliances
- ◆ Furniture



Please note that the City **cannot** accept building materials (i.e. lumber, sheetrock, plaster, concrete, siding materials), carpet, insulation or roofing material.

Items not out on your regular pick-up day will not be considered part of the free service, will be picked up only at the resident's request, and regular bulky item pick-up fees will be charged. If you have questions, please contact Public Works at 816-858-4815.

Help Improve 911 Response to Your Home

Address visibility is a key to fast emergency response to your home.

Making your home address more visible from the street will help ambulance, fire and other emergency responders to locate your house

- ◆ Address Numbers should be at least 4 inches high
- ◆ Numbers should be a contrasting color from your house color
- ◆ Make sure address is not screened by trees, bushes and flowers
- ◆ Reflective letters are recommended but not required

Check your address from the street, if it hard for you to see, it is much more difficult for ambulance, fire and other first responders to find you in an emergency.

EXCITING CHANGES COMING

FOR

CURBSIDE RECYCLING.

This fall, the City will replace the 18 gallon red recycling bins with the larger 95 gallon wheeled bin shown at right. This change will occur with no additional charge to ratepayer.

In addition to the materials we currently take – aluminum cans, 1-7 plastics, tin cans, paper (including newspaper, magazines, office paper, advertising inserts, envelopes); we will also begin accepting cardboard and paperboard. This will include things such as cereal boxes, paper boxes, corrugated boxes, drink cartons, moving boxes, etc.

Glass will no longer be accepted; however glass can be dropped off at our recycle center at 108 Paxton, or at the Ripple Glass container in the parking lot at Price Chopper.

The new carts are expected in later summer. More information will be sent monthly.
