The wheeled carts replace the current green bin system. Please give the new carts a try for at least a month or two. We believe they will help you recycle and make for a easier trash day each week.

On line CREDIT/ DEBIT Card: Set up your monthly credit or debit payments at www.plattecitecity.org/online . Convenience fee applies to this option.

Bank Check Payment: Set up City of Platte City as a payee through your bank and let them send your payment to the City. Give your bank 3 to 5 days to get the check to us.

Automatic Bank Draft: Your bank can automatically make your payment each month with this option. Fill out application at City Hall along with voided check.

Pay by mail or in person at City Hall, 400 Main Street. After hours drop box on Fourth Street **or Call in** credit or debit payments at 858-3046. Convenience fees apply.

Crime Prevention Tips

Vacation Tips:

- Before you go on vacation contact the Platte City Police at 858-5150 to request a “**vacation watch in passing**”. Officers on patrol will be aware you are not home and will patrol past your home on a more frequent basis.
- When on vacation, suspend newspaper deliver and have your mail held a the post office.
- Use timers to activate lights and to turn radio on/off.
- If gone in winter, arrange for prompt snow removal.

Reduce Opportunities for Crime

- Lock windows and doors. Install and use deadbolt.
- Place rod in track of sliding door to prevent opening
- Install exterior lights with motion detectors
- Do not leave car keys in vehicle, even in your driveway
- Lock all vehicles even in your garage and driveway
- Do not leave cell phones, tablets or other expensive items in any easily visible part of your vehicle.
- Get to know your neighbors; help organize a Neighborhood Watch. Call Platte City Police at 858-5150 to start.
