RECYCLING PROGRAM UPDATE

Please use new bins for recycling only. Remember, most of your household waste

There are no extra costs or charges to you for the new recycling bins and bin service

The new bins allow you to recycle almost everything in your normal trash except glass, food waste, Styrofoam, paint, aerosols, plastic bags and greasy items (used paper towels, pizza box).

Because the majority of household waste can now be recycled, the new bins can become the first option for your household/kitchen waste.

Examples of recyclable materials include:

- Paper, magazines, mail and newspaper (except used paper towels)
- Food boxes including cereal boxes, cake mix boxes, pasta/cracker boxes, etc
- Plastic containers, including milk jugs, soda bottles, plastic jars, etc
- All other plastics except plastic bags (grocery, storage and frozen food bags)
- Metal/aluminum cans including meat & vegetable cans, soup & soda cans
- Cardboard, cardboard towel rolls and cardboard boxes (except pizza box)

PET LICENSE FOR CATS AND DOGS

Annual Dog and Cat registration and licensing is due January 1st. If your dog or cat is registered please renew. If your pet is not registered or licensed you are encouraged to do so.

It costs very little to register your pet and has several advantages and protections for you and your pet:

Costs:

License a neutered or spayed cat:	\$5.00
License a neutered or spayed dog:	\$5.00
License an intact male/female cat:	\$10.00
License an intact male/female dog:	\$10.00

Advantages:

- A licensed pet is much more likely to be found and returned.
- A licensed pet found by animal control will be returned.
- Licensing ensures animals have current rabies vaccinations.

On line CREDIT/ DEBIT Card: Set up your monthly credit or debit payments at www.plattecity.org/online . Convenience fee applies to this option.

Bank Check Payment: Set up City of Platte City as a payee through your bank and let them send your payment to the City. Give your bank 3 to 5 days to get the check to us.

Automatic Bank Draft: Your bank can automatically make your payment each month with this option. Fill out application at City Hall along with a voided check.

Pay by mail or in person at City Hall, 400 Main Street. After hours drop box available at curb on Fourth Street side of City Hall . You may also **Call in** credit or debit payments at 858-3046. Convenience fees apply.

YARD WASTE FACILITY CLOSURES NOVEMBER 30th

The City’s Yard Waste/Green Waste Drop Off Facility will close for the winter on Saturday, November 30th at sunset.

The facility will reopen for Christmas Trees the first two weeks in January.

The Yard Waste Drop Off Facility will re-open for normal operations on March 1, 2014.

Facility use is restricted to Platte City residents.

The Yard Waste/Green Waste Drop Off Facility is located in Riverview Park at the west end of Mill Street.
