**Recycling News GOOD and Not So GOOD**

**Good News:** There is 100 tons of good news for the first six months of the new curbside recycling program. Residents have reduced trash tonnage and increased recycling tonnage by 100 tons compared to the same six months last year. The reduction in tonnage sent to the landfill is a direct savings of \$3,400 in landfill tipping fees. This is equal to almost three months fuel for the City's trash and recycling trucks.

**Not So Good News:** The bad news in recycling is that it is too easy to put trash instead of recycling in the new wheeled containers. Please use the green wheeled containers for recycling only.

Solid Waste crews will tag and empty containers the first time they contain trash rather than recycling. **Containers tagged more than once will not be serviced by solid waste crews.** Contact Public Works at 858-4815 or visit [www.plattecitey.org](http://www.plattecitey.org) for recycling questions.
