Snow Plowing, Winter Driving and Snow Routes.

- Help City Snow Crews clean streets, **please remove vehicles from the street during/immediately after snow storms.** Moving your vehicle off the street makes it easier for plows to clean all the way to the curb.
- **To avoid plows refilling your driveway,** please clear the edge of the street 3 feet wide by 6 feet long upstream of your driveway. (the portion of the City street/curb/gutter to your left as you face the street)
- **Drive safely during and after snow and ice events.** Give yourself more time to reach destination, accelerate and stop gradually, drive at lower speeds and avoid hills whenever possible.
- **Pay attention to Snow Route signs.** Do not park on designated snow routes.
- Call Public Works at 816.858.4815 to report snow or ice related road problems or concerns

Be A Responsible Pet Owner

Sharing your life with a dog or cat can be a source of great joy. However, having a pet also comes with responsibilities both to your pet and to your neighbors. Following are a few tips for responsible pet ownership:

- Spay or Neuter your dog or cat. Contact your local veterinarian or City Hall for more information.
- Accept responsibility if your dog or cat does have a litter. Contact the Great Plains SPCA, Wayside Waifs or City Hall for assistance or more information.
- If you can no longer care for your pet. Contact the Great Plains SPCA, Wayside Waifs or City Hall for assistance or more information.
- Vaccinate and license your pets. Vaccines prevent the spread of disease, licensing helps bring your pet home.
- Dog owners should be aware of their dogs barking habits. Do not allow constant barking to impact your neighbor's ability to enjoy their property. Bring barking dogs inside or train your dogs to limit their barking.
