**Overlay Project
Invitation to Bid**

1. **PROJECT:** Williamsburg Terrace, Devonshire, Kempton Court, Eagle Ridge, Higgins, Running Horse Terrace and portions of Running Horse Road and Platte Falls Road (see project description.)
2. **BIDS RECEIVED UNTIL:** 10:00 a.m. on Wednesday, January 28, 2015, at City Hall, 400 Main Street, Platte City, Missouri, at which time and place bids will be publicly opened and read aloud.
3. **DESCRIPTION OF WORK:**
The placement of 2” thick Type III asphaltic surface. Recycled material is acceptable.
4. **ALL BIDS** must be in accordance with the Bid Documents on file at City Hall, 400 Main Street, Platte City, Missouri. Bids will be received on a unit price basis for the street improvements.
5. **BID DOCUMENTS** may be obtained through City Hall, 400 Main Street, Platte City, Missouri, phone number 816-858-3046.
6. **WORK TIMING:** The work is to be commenced within fifteen calendar days after the Notice to Proceed is issued. Rapid completion of the work is desired.
7. **PREVAILING WAGE:** Pursuant to RSMo section 290 not less than the prevailing hourly rate of wages, as set out in the wage order attached to and made part of these specifications for work, must be paid to all workers performing work on this project.
8. **BIDDER’S QUESTIONS AND COMMENTS** relative to these bidding documents should be submitted to Leonard Hendricks, Public Works Director at 816-858-4815. Comments should reach this office no later than eight calendar days prior to the date set for opening of bids, in order that changes, if needed, may be added by addendum.
9. **PRE-BID CONFERENCE:** Will be held at 10:00 a.m. on Thursday, January 22, 2015 at 400 Main Street, Platte City, Missouri. Representatives of owner will be present to answer questions.
10. **BIDDERS** on this work may be required to name subcontractors and manufacturers on the Bid Form.
11. **BID SECURITY REQUIREMENTS:** All bids must be accompanied by a certified check, cashier’s check or a bid bond for not less than 5% of the amount bid (including alternates), made payable to the City of Platte City, Missouri.

12. AWARD OF THE CONTRACT will be made on the basis of the lowest responsive, responsible evaluated bid. Payment for work under this contract will be made on the basis set forth in the General Conditions.

13. BID ACCEPTANCE OR REJECTION: Owner reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive irregularities therein, including without limitation the rights to reject any or all nonconforming, nonresponsive, unbalanced or conditional Bids and to reject the bid of any Bidder if Owner believes that it would not be in the best interest of the Project to make an award to that Bidder, whether because the Bid is not responsive or the Bidder is unqualified or of doubtful financial ability or fails to meet any other pertinent standard or criteria established by the Owner. Owner also reserves the right to waive all informalities not involving price, time or changes in the Work and to negotiate contract terms with the Successful Bidder. All Bidders must agree that such rejection shall be without liability on the part of the Owner for any damage or claim brought by any Bidder because of such rejections, and the filing of any Bid in response to this invitation shall constitute an agreement of the Bidder to these conditions.

14. PERFORMANCE AND PAYMENT BONDS are required under the base bid on this project.

15. INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS: Bidders must be properly licensed under the state laws governing their respective trade. Insurance in a form acceptable to the City will be required of the successful bidder.

16. BUSINESS LICENSE; Winning bidder and any sub-contractors must obtain City business license prior to start of project.

17. SUBMITTAL: Submit original and one copy of bid, along with bid security in a sealed envelope. Identify the envelope as follows:

18. PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS:

- a. 2" Asphaltic Concrete Street Surface: The Contract Unit Price bid for this item shall constitute full compensation for furnishing all materials, labor, equipment and tools for the construction of a 2" thick course of Type III asphaltic concrete surface material. Recycled material is acceptable. This item includes all material, compaction, seal coating, batch plant testing, material quality monitoring, hauling, maintenance of haul road, permits and all work and materials necessary to complete the work in accordance with the Bid Documents. Payment for this item shall be per ton placed.

It is the intent of the Owner to have curb base preparation complete before contractor. All material criteria will be latest edition APWA Standards. This is a per-ton laid in place project.
