The City's annual spring clean-up will be here soon! Spring Clean up is scheduled for April 18-21, 2017. Large and bulky items will be picked up on your regular trash pick-up day; please have items out at the curb by 6:30 a.m.



The following items will be picked up free of charge during the spring clean up event only: " Brush and small limbs (cut to 4' lengths and bundled) " Yard waste – leaves and grass clippings (bagged in paper bags only) " Tires (limit of 4 per household) " Appliances " Furniture Please note that the City **cannot** accept building materials (i.e. lumber, sheetrock, plaster, concrete, siding materials), carpet, insulation or roofing material.

**\*Only items placed at the curb on the regular pick-up day will be considered for this free service. Other items may be picked up at the resident's request, and regular bulky item pick-up fees will be charged. If you have questions, please contact Public Works at 816-858-4815.**

## Door to Door Sales Information

Spring and summer weather often lead to an increase in door to door sales efforts. Door to door sales are allowed by registered vendors from 8 am to 9 pm (or 30 minutes after sunset whichever is earlier). Door to door salespeople are required to register with the City and receive a door to door sales permit. Door to door vendors must show the permit to property owners upon request.

Individuals or groups conducting door to door communication **not involving sales** are not required to have a permit.

Property owners may prohibit door to door salespeople from coming to the door by posting a visible "No Solicitation sign" on or near the front door of the residence. This allows the property owner to invoke their property rights.

Posting a "No Solicitation" sign does not prohibit individuals engaged in door to door communication **not involving sales** from coming to the door.

Property owners may at any time notify any individual that they not welcome and may request the person leave their property.

## Green Waste Facility Now Open

The green waste facility is now open for Platte City Residents. You may purchase or renew your green waste facility access card anytime now. Access cards are \$20.00 per year.

New access cards can be purchased at City Hall Monday-Friday 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. except observed holidays.

Renewal of your access cards can be done at City Hall, or can be billed on your next utility bill simply contact City Hall at 816-858-3046 and request renewal..

City residents may drop off green waste (yard debris, grass clippings, brush, tree branches etc) at the green waste facility located in Riverview Park at the end of Mill Street.
