

WATER AND SEWER RATE CHANGE EFFECTIVE JUNE 1st

A small water and wastewater rate change will occur on June 1st. The first bill with the new rates will be mailed on July 5th.

Water Rate Change: The minimum monthly water charge will increase by 15 cents on each bill. This change will increase monthly water costs by 15 cents which equals an annual water rate change of \$1.80 for each service address. The water rate charged for each additional one thousand gallons of use will not change this year. This rate change increases revenue enough to recover the annual wholesale water rate increase from the Kansas City Missouri Water Department, the water supply agency for Platte City.

Wastewater Rate Change: Wastewater rates will change by 18 cents for the minimum bill and for each one thousand gallons of use. For customers receiving a minimum bill this will result in a 18 cent per month increase for a total annual change of \$2.16. For a standard customer (5,000 gals per month), the monthly impact will be an additional 90 cents for a total annual change of \$10.80.

The small annual increases in water and wastewater rates ensures that the City can provide safe, clean drinking water and to completely and safely treat wastewater before releasing it back into area rivers. Water and wastewater fees pay for day to day utility operations, long term water/wastewater infrastructure maintenance and replacement and reductions in the need for larger increases in future years.

Platte City's utility systems and other infrastructure remain in good material and working condition due to revenue generated by local customers and ratepayers. Although Platte City will actively seek to leverage any available state or federal utility funding, the federal infrastructure programs are not currently funded or guaranteed. Any federal or state funds that do become available will be used to reduce the impact of future water and wastewater rates.

Reminder: Prepare your Home for Vacation...

Vacation is for fun and relaxation. Help save yourself some worry about what could be happening at home by protecting it from theft and damage while you are away. Here is a checklist we have developed to help you have a relaxing and peaceful vacation.

- Make sure all electrical appliances are turned off.
- Clean the refrigerator of all perishable foods, and take out the garbage.
- Lock all windows and doors.
- Arrange to have the newspaper and mail held until your return, or have them picked up by a trusted neighbor.
- Arrange to have your lawn mowed (or snow shoveled) while you are away. Ask a neighbor to set out your trash on collection day and then retrieve empty cans and recycling bins the same day.
- Let a trusted neighbor know you will be away and have them keep an eye on your home. It is a good idea to leave your vacation address and telephone number with a neighbor so you can be reached in case of an emergency.
- Never leave your house key hidden outside your home.
- Set timers on interior lights.
- Make sure to unplug televisions, computers and appliances susceptible to lightning and power surges.
- Advise your alarm company and local police if you will be gone for an extended period.
- Store jewelry and valuable items in a safe-deposit box.
- Arrange for the care of pets.
- Set the heating system to provide minimum heat of 55 degrees.
