

Apply now for 2017-18 Property Revitalization Matching Grants

The City is now accepting applications from Platte City property owners for the 2017-18 residential and downtown business matching grant programs.

Eligible property owners can be reimbursed up to 50% of the cost of business and home improvement projects. Homeowners can receive a grant of up to \$10,000; business owners can receive a grant of up to \$20,000.

Applications will be reviewed and eligible projects approved on a first come, first served basis until all grant funds have been awarded. The program helps increase property values by providing a financial incentive for property owners to reinvest in their home or downtown business.

SNOW CLEARING TIPS:



Platte City's top priority in a snowstorm is plowing snow routes, which may require several trips down the same route. Snow plowed from roads could block private driveways for some time. Due to limited time and resources during a snow event, plows can only clear private driveways at the request of local emergency officials.

To reduce the amount of snow that may block your driveway, shovel an open area along the shoulder at the entrance (see illustration to the right). Plow blades will then push snow into the area just before your driveway and leave a much smaller amount of snow in front of your driveway.

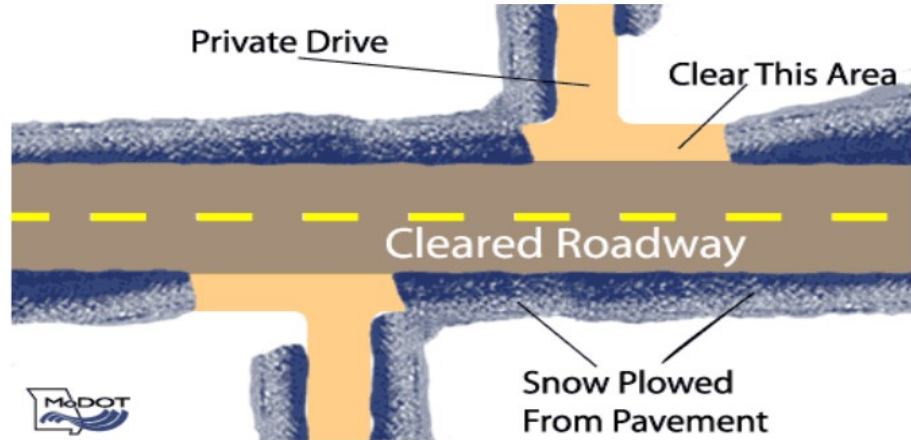

General Election Opens December 12, 2017

Candidate filing opens December 12, 2017 and closes January 16, 2018. Candidates may file for the offices listed below with the City Clerk during business hours Monday-Friday 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

- Mayor 2 Year Term
- Alderman of Ward One 2 Year Term
- Alderman of Ward Two 1 Year Term
- Alderman of Ward Two 2 Year Term
- Alderman of Ward Three 2 Year Term

City offices closed December 22nd, 25th & January 1st.

Qualifications for declaration of candidacy Mayor:

- At least 25 years of age
- Registered voter
- A resident of Platte City for 1 year prior to the election (you must have been a resident of Platte City no later than April 2, 2017 to be eligible)

Qualifications for declaration of candidacy Alderman:

- At least 18 years of age
- Registered voter
- A resident of Platte City for 1 year prior to the election (Must have been a resident of Platte City no later than April 2, 2017 to be eligible)
- A resident of the ward in which you are filing
